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## Careers Provision (2017-2018)

### Year 8 – PSHE lessons

PSHE lessons on finance and careers (7 lessons)

- The Real game – dream jobs and lifestyle
- Real job research and requirements
- Budgeting and expenses
- Realistic expectations
- Opportunities in jobs
- Work and employability skills
- Personality types, individual skills and jobs
- Careers research

### Year 8 – Careers Interviews

Students who may need additional support or reassurance when making their GCSE option choices are referred to our independent Careers Adviser from teaching staff. Parents are invited to refer their child too.

### Year 8 – Options Evening

The school's Independent Careers Adviser is available to parents and students during this event to help support the decision making process. Parents are advised of this before attending.

### Year 9 - Work Insight day

Employers from a range of occupational sectors come into school and deliver participative workshops and presentations to year 9 students introducing them to the vast number of different roles within that sector across different qualification levels. Students have time in the day to do independent careers research. Students off timetable for the day.

### Year 10 - Work experience

All students attend a work experience placement for one week. At school in PSHE lessons students complete

- CV completion
- Work experience documentation - application form and letter
- Health and safety in the workplace information

### Year 10 – Taster days

All students have the opportunity to attend taster sessions with our local colleges and sixth form providers.

### Year 11 – Careers interviews

All students are entitled to meet and are invited to attend a meeting with our independent careers advisor at least once during the year, but more if necessary.

### Year 11 – College Assembly Talks

All students attend three college, sixth form and apprenticeship talks to receive information about courses they offer and apprenticeship up dates.

### Year 11 – PSHE lessons

All students complete online and hard copy college application forms in PSHE lessons. They also study
