Dear Parents/Carers,

REMINDER: Uniform Update (Footwear) – effective September 2019

I am writing to you to offer a polite reminder that we are continuing to develop our uniform policy to reflect the aspirations that we have for Longhill High School. We believe that students in years 7 – 11 should be dressed professionally which helps to establish the correct attitude for learning.

Whilst our uniform list remains unchanged for September 2019, we are focusing on ensuring that students are dressed smartly and appropriately in all aspects of their uniform. I would therefore like to bring your attention, in particular, to the following:

As from September 2019 all students will be expected to wear black school shoes, not trainers.

The uniform guidance on our website has been updated to include formal footwear (shoes) leather or leather like material that can be polished, in readiness for September 2019. In the meantime we ask that when footwear needs replacing, that you consider replacing them with a formal shoe in preparation for September 2019. I have also enclosed some examples of acceptable footwear on the following page as a guide.

The compulsory uniform includes the school blazer, ties, PE kit and regulation trousers and skirts.
