### **Year 6 Online Parents Evening**

As we had to cancel our new intake evening and taster day due to Covid 19 we are running online webinars on the final week of the term to explain the role of the mentor and what to expect when starting secondary school. These will take place on:

Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 5:30 – 6:00pm  
Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> of July 5:00 – 5:30pm  
Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> of July 6:00 – 6:30pm

The presentation will be the same each night so you only need to attend one webinar. We will email you with details on how to access the session the week before.

Your child's mentor will be an important contact for both you and your child and I will be working closely with them to ensure that their transition is smooth and successful in the coming weeks and months.

Please be reassured that there will be specific transition plans and **a dedicated induction day just for our Year 7 students on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September** to support them in settling within our school community and finding their feet as they start their secondary school adventure with us. **Students must arrive by 8:20am** and head towards the Sports Centre where they will be placed into Mentor groups and ready to start their induction day.
